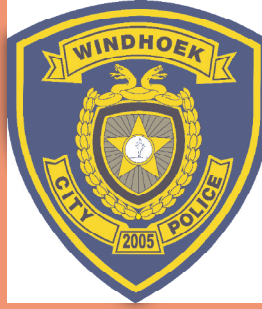

HERE ARE A FEW ATM TIPS TO KEEP IN MIND, TO KEEP SAFE

LEAVING YOUR PROPERTY

- **Inform City Police** so that Zonal operational patrols will keep a extra eye during patrol.
- **NEVER LEAVE** Vacant property it's a easy target.
- **Report suspicious** movements in your area immediately! Don't underestimate the difference your call can make!

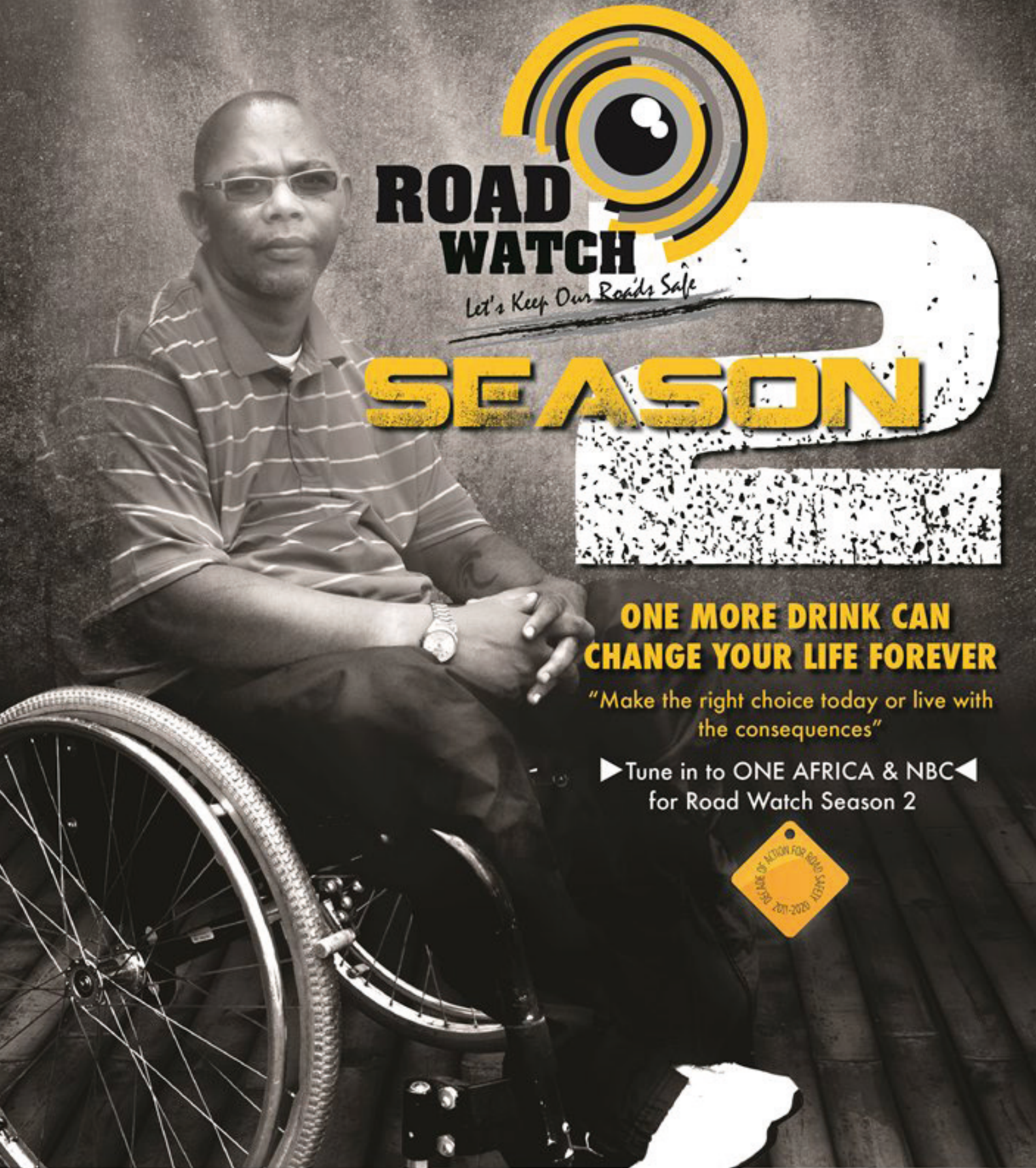
